



Corporate Challenge 2018

EVENT RULES & SCORING

Once all teams have completed an activity, event scores will be awarded according to placement. Scoring for all events will be determined by the number of teams plus 10; for example, if there are twenty teams, 1st place will receive 30 points, 2nd place 29, 3rd place 28, and 20th place 11 points. In the case of a tie, a tiebreaker will be used whenever possible. If the tie cannot be broken, the teams involved will equally divide the place points.

Bowling

Sunday, Aug. 12th @ 11:00am & 2:00pm

Flint Hills Lanes

Teams will consist of 4 members, with at least one female participant. The event will use the “9 pin no tap” format in which 9 pins knocked down will count as a strike. As a bonus, special prizes will be given if a “True Strike” is bowled (first ball only) when a colored pin is in the head pin position. The event will consist of 3 games. Placing will be determined by the highest combination scratch total of all 4 bowlers for all 3 games. There will be a 10-minute practice prior to the start of the competition.

Computer scoring is final.

Badminton

Monday, Aug. 13th @ 6:00pm

EHS Gymnasiums

Badminton will consist of (2) single 10-minute games, rally points scoring. Each team will consist of 2 players, with at least one female participant. Drawing for the team play will happen at 6:00 pm, the evening of the event. Play begins with a coin toss to determine the serving team and choice of sides. The team that wins the point will be awarded the serve for the next volley. Play will continue until the 10-minute time period and then teams will rotate to the left to determine the next game’s opponents.

Disc Golf

Tuesday, Aug. 14th @ 6:00pm

Jones Park (West Course)

The 18-hole course will be used with a 2-member team, with at least one female participant. Individuals from 4 different teams will be playing together with all teams starting at the same time using a shotgun start. Team members will each be completing 9 holes. Discs and putters will be provided or you may bring your own. Teeing order on the first tee will be assigned. Teeing order on all subsequent tees is determined by the scores on the previous hole, with the lowest score throwing first, and so on. Maximum strokes per hole will be 7. By adding the combined number of strokes from both team members, the lowest total score will win the first-place spot. In case of a tie, the winner will be determined by a playoff.

Darts

Wednesday, Aug. 15th @ 6:00pm

Brickyard 20 Ale House

This will be a “**double**” elimination tournament with a 2- member team, with at least one female participant. Eight matches of “501” will be played at a time (16 teams). Soft tip darts will be provided or you may bring your own. The game of “501” will be played, the best two out of three games. The first team to win two games shall be the winner. A limit of 10 rounds per game will be played. Participants each take a turn, throwing 3 darts in succession, constituting a round. When playing in the loser’s bracket, only one game will be played to determine the team moving on. Dartboards will be electronic and will keep the scores.

Wacky Water Relay

Thursday, Aug. 16th @ 6:00pm

Jones Aquatic Center

Teams will consist of 4 members, with at least one female participant. Details of this teamwork challenge will be explained at the event. The depth of the pool will never exceed 5 foot. Best overall time wins the event.

Baggo**Friday, Aug. 17th @ 6:00pm****Peter Pan Park**

This will be a single elimination tournament with a two-member team, any combination of male/female. Baggo, is a game of skill, in which individuals will compete against one another to be the team with the most points after 12 frames. There will be a 20-minute time limit for each game. The game consists of two Baggo boards located 27 feet apart. Two teams play at one time, with one member of each team standing at opposite Baggo boards. The object is to land the bag in the hole, or on the board, to score. The opposing team member standing on the same side then tosses one of their bags. The two players alternate throwing until each player has thrown all 4 bags. Whichever team scores the highest points each frame determines the first player tossing in the next frame. A bag that goes through the hole scores 3 points. Any bag that comes to rest on the board at the end of the frame scores 1 point.

Putt Putt**Monday, Aug. 20th @ 6:00pm****Emporia Family Fun Center**

Both 18-hole courses will be used for this 4-member team competition. Teams must have at least one female participant. Team members will all start at different holes with 4 teams playing together using a shotgun start. The team scoring the lowest will win the first-place spot. In case of a tie, the winner will be determined by a playoff.

Canoe Race**Tuesday, Aug. 21st @ 6:00pm****Grimsley Lake**

This will be a 3-person timed race, with at least one female participant. Details of this teamwork challenge will be explained at the event. The canoes, oars, and a limited supply of life jackets will be provided. Participants are encouraged to bring their own life jacket. Since we will be on private property, NO alcoholic beverages will be permitted.

Bocce**Wednesday, Aug. 22nd @ 6:00pm****Peter Pan Park (grass area)**

This will be a single elimination tournament with a 4-member team, any combination, male or female. Two players from each team are stationed at opposite ends of the court and play alternate frames or innings. The team winning the coin toss begins by tossing the pallino (target ball) anywhere they want in the playing area, then will roll or toss one of the larger balls as close to the pallino as possible. The starting team does not bowl again until the opposing team has succeeded in getting one of their balls closer to the pallino. The teams continue this way, with individual players alternating, until one side has used up all its balls, whereupon the other side is entitled to bowl its remaining balls. This ends a frame. Play switches to the opposite side of the court with each frame. One point is awarded for every ball that is closer to the pallino than the closest ball of the opposing team. The team, which wins a frame on points, starts play in the next frame. **A game will be played to 20 points or a 20-minute time limit.**

Bolo**Thursday, Aug. 23rd @ 6:00pm****Peter Pan Park**

This will be a single elimination tournament with a 2-member team, any combination, male or female. Bolo is a game of skill and luck, in which individuals will compete against one another to be the first to reach a winning score of 30. There will be a 20-minute time limit for each game. The game consists of two bolo standards located at a designated distance apart. Two teams play at one time, with one member of each team standing at opposite standards. The object is to wrap your "bolo" around one of the three horizontal poles, to score points. An under-hand toss will be the only accepted delivery with only one golf ball of the bolo string being held in your hand. In case of a tie, decide which player will lead off. The first player will throw 3 consecutive bolos and tally their score. The second player will then throw their 3 bolos and tally the score. The player with the highest score breaks the TIE and wins that game.
