

**Emporia Recreation Commission Natatorium and Facilities
Unsupervised Child Release Form**

In consideration for being permitted to use the Emporia Recreation Commission Natatorium and facilities, the undersigned adult, parent, legal guardian, or authorized agent of a parent or legal guardian of a minor acknowledges and voluntarily agrees to the following:

1. Recreational user(s) will abide by all policies, procedures, and rules regarding the swimming pool and facilities.
2. Children between the ages of 7 and 15 may use the natatorium without adult supervision.
3. A signed agreement must be filled out and dropped off by a parent/legal guardian with a valid picture ID that will be kept on file in case of an emergency, incidents, etc.
4. Patrons are asked to enter/exit through the locker rooms and shower before entering the pool area.
5. The pool is not to be used unless a lifeguard is on duty.
6. A swim test will be conducted for all children under the age of 10 who wish to use the diving board/deep end.
7. When using the diving board, only one person on the board at one time and the diving area must be completely clear. Jump straight off the board.
8. Unsafe jumps are not permitted.
9. Food and drink are not permitted in the pool area.
10. No running or horseplay on the pool deck or in locker rooms.
11. All valuables should be locked in a locker.
12. Gum is not permitted in the pool area.
13. Band-Aids should be removed before using the pool.
14. Kickboards, dumbbells, weights, etc are for instructional purposes only.
